Jazz Musicians Celebrate Memorial Plaque At Miles Davis' Former Home

The former home of a jazz legend has hit a high note.

The Upper West Side building where Miles Davis once lived and worked is marked with a cultural medallion by a historical landmark group.

Experts say jazz classics including, "Kind Of Blue," were recorded inside Davis' former home at 213 West 77th Street.

Many of those who worked with him there were on hand for the commemoration ceremony.

The building is the first installation of the "Landmark 50" program, a project by the Historic Landmark Preservation Center that aims to put medallions on culturally significant buildings all across the city over the next two years.
